History: St. John Church is a non-Indian parish. However, diocesan priests from St. John's have attended St. Catherine Mission, Nowata, also a non-Indian parish, from which diocesan priests attended the following Indian missions and station:

1906-1911 (transferred to Immaculate Conception, Pawhuska)	St. Joseph Mission (Pawnee), Cleveland
1925-1931 (became a mission)	Claremore station (Cherokee)
1931-1939 (closed)	Sacred Heart Mission (Cherokee), Claremore
