History: St. Ann Church is a non-Indian parish that has attended Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church, Sterling, also a non-Indian parish. Diocesan priests from Our Lady of Perpetual Help attended Mother of Sorrows Church, Apache.

History of Mother of Sorrows Church

1908-1979	Diocesan priests established and administered Mother of Sorrows Church (Apache)
1979-unknown	Diocesan priests attended Mother of Sorrows from Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Sterling
Unknown-present	Diocesan priests attended Mother of Sorrows from St. Ann's

1949-1979 (closed)	Immaculate Conception Mission (Apache and Caddo), Cyril
1970-1974 (transferred to St. Patrick's, Anadarko)	St. Richard Mission (Kiowa), Carnegie
