History: Sacred Heart Church is a non-Indian parish that had a school which included a few American Indian students (various). Also, Benedictines (now St. Benedict's Abbey, Shawnee, Oklahoma) from Sacred Heart attended the following Indian stations:

1890-1891 (transferred to St. Patrick's, Anadarko)	Fort Sill station (Apache and Comanche)
1890-1913 (closed)	Fort Reno station (Cheyenne)
ca. 1949-1981	Concho Government Indian School (various)
