History: St. Mary Church is a non-Indian parish. However, Benedictines (now St. Benedict's Abbey, Shawnee, Oklahoma) from St. Mary's attended the following Indian stations:

1889-1895 (transferred to St. Felix's, Otoe Reservation station  
Ponca City)  
1889-ca. 1894 (transferred to St. Pawnee Reservation station  
John's, Gray Horse)  
1889-1895 (transferred to St. Felix's, Ponca Reservation station  
Ponca City)  
1889-ca. 1894 (closed) Iowa Reservation station
