History: St. Mary/ St. Felix Church is a non-Indian parish, which had a school that included a few American Indian students (Ponca and others). Also, diocesan priests from St. Mary's attended the following Indian stations:

1895-1910 (closed)	Otoe Reservation station
1895-1902 (closed)	Kaw Reservation station (Kansa)
1895-1909 (became a mission)	Tonkawa station (Tonkawa)
1909-1911 (transferred to St. Joseph's, Blackwell) (no longer Indian)	St. Joseph Mission (Tonkawa), Tonkawa
1897-1904 (closed)	Lillivole station (Ponca)
1899-1906 (transferred to St. Francis, Newkirk)	Chilocco Government Indian School (various)
1904-1909 (closed)	White Eagle station (Ponca)
