1909-1910 Diocesan priests attended Skiatook station from Sacred
Heart, Sapulpa
1921-present Diocesan priests established and have administered St.
William's/ Sacred Heart Church (Osage)

missions and stations:

1921-1922 (transferred to St. Patrick's, Sand Springs)	St. Joseph Mission (Pawnee), Cleveland
1921-1925 (closed)	Avant station (Osage)
1921-1925 (closed)	Big Heart Settlement station (Osage)
1921-1926 (transferred to Immaculate Conception, Pawhuska)	Hominy station (Osage)
1925-1942 (became a mission)	Barnsdell station (Osage)
1939-1940 (became a parish)	Claremore station (Cherokee)
1940-1948 (became a parish)	Christ the King Mission (Cherokee), Claremore
1942-1980 (transferred to Immaculate Conception, Pawhuska)	St. Mary Mission (Osage), Barnsdell
