History: St. Francis Xavier Church is a non-Indian parish, which had a school that included a few American Indian students (various). Also, diocesan priests from St. Francis attended the following Indian missions and station:

1900-1901 (became a mission)	Pawnee station (Pawnee)
1901-1904 (transferred to St. John's, Gray Horse)	St. John the Evangelist Mission (Pawnee), Pawnee
1901-1904 (transferred to Immaculate Conception, Pawhuska)	Cleveland station (Pawnee)
1915-1925 (became a parish)	Sacred Heart Mission (Osage), Fairfax
1915-1949 (transferred to Sacred Heart, Fairfax) (no longer Indian)	St. John the Evangelist Mission (Pawnee), Pawnee
