History: Holy Cross Church is a non-Indian parish. However, diocesan priests from Holy Cross attended the following Indian missions and stations:

1909 (became a parish)(no longer Indian)	Precious Blood Mission (Creek), Eufala
1909 (transferred to Precious Blood, Eufala)	Checotah station (Creek)
1909-1915 (closed)	Fort Gibson station (Cherokee)
1909-1912, 1942-1948	Tahlequah station (Cherokee)
1909-1917 (transferred to Assumption, Muskogee)	Webber's Falls station (Cherokee)
1912-1917 (transferred to Assumption, Muskogee)	St. Mary Mission, Tahlequah
1914-1917 (transferred to Holy Family, Tulsa)	Claremore station (Cherokee)
1942-1954 (transferred to Assumption, Muskogee)	St. Joseph Mission (Cherokee), Webber's Falls
1948-1967 (became a parish) (no longer Indian)	St. Brigid Mission (Cherokee), Tahlequah
1958-1967 (transferred to St. Brigid's, Tahlequah)	Cherokee Government Indian School
