Description: Letters from Croke to Archbishop Francis Xavier Norbert Blanchet (1795-1883), concerning the state of the Catholic Church in Oregon.

/2 "Collection of Catholic Prayers and Teachings in Various Indian Languages, SFM85"

Inclusive dates: ca. 1908

Volume: 5 items

Description: In Nez Perce, Eskimo, and Kalispel languages; collected by Reverend Schoenberg, S.J.

/3 "Lee Moorhouse Photograph Collection"

Inclusive dates: Between 1897-1920

Volume: At least 7 prints

Description: St. Andrew Mission (Cayuse, Umatilla, Walla Walla, and Nez Perce) and visit of Bishop Charles J. O'Reilly to the Umatilla Reservation; at least 7 images online.
