History:

1861-1864	Diocesan priests established and attended the Umatilla Reservation station (Cayuse, Nez Perce, Umatilla, and Walla Walla)
1865-1868, 1888-present	Jesuits (formerly Turin and California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) have administered St. Andrew Mission, Umatilla Reservation
1868-1888	Diocesan priests administered St. Andrew's
1888-1970s	Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia (Aston, Pennsylvania) established and administered St. Ann School, Umatilla Reservation, until it became a charter school

Diocesan priests from St. Andrew's attended St. Ann Mission, 1869-1872

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans:

Inclusive dates: 1865-present
