History:

1839-before 1900 (no longer Indian) Reverend Modest Demers established and diocesan priests have administered St. Paul Mission (Cayuse, Grand Ronde, Métis, and others), St. Paul/ Willamette Valley/ French Prairie

Diocesan priests from St. Paul's attended the following Indian school, parish, and station:

1839 Willamette Academy (various and Métis), Willamette
1858 (closed) Yam Hills Church (Cayuse), Yam Hills
1859-1861 (transferred to Grand Ronde Reservation station (Grand Ronde)
St. Peter's, The Dalles)
