History: The Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia were founded in Philadelphia in 1855 and staffed the following Indian schools:

1887-1949	St. Louis Girls Boarding School (Osage), Pawhuska, Oklahoma; destroyed by fire in 1889 and reopened the same year
1888-1948	St. Elizabeth Boarding School (Chickasaw and Choctaw), Purcell, Oklahoma
1888-1907	St. John School (Osage), Gray Horse, Oklahoma
1892-present	St. Stephen's School (Arapaho and Shoshoni), St. Stephens, Wind River Reservation, Wyoming
1899-ca. 1940 (no longer Indian)	St. Joseph School (Chickasaw), Chickasha, Oklahoma
1901-1948	St. Elizabeth Day School (Chickasaw and Choctaw), Purcell, Oklahoma
1901-1913	St. Louis Day School (Osage), Pawhuska, Osage Reservation, Oklahoma

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans are unknown.
