History: The Sisters of Sainte Anne were founded in Quebec, Canada, in 1850 and made their first foundation in the United States in 1866. The Sisters of St. Anne have administered the following provinces, which at least in part, have included Indian and Eskimo missions and parishes in what is now the United States:

1889-unknown (transferred to St. Joseph's Province)	General Motherhouse (Lachine, Quebec, Canada)
unknown-ca. 1914 (transferred to St. Marie Province)	St. Joseph's Province (Victoria, British Columbia, Canada)
ca. 1914-present	St. Marie Province (Marlboro, Massachusetts)
