History: The Soeurs grises were founded in Quebec, Canada, in 1737 and staffed the following Santee Indian schools, Fort Totten Reservation, North Dakota:

1874	Our Lady of Sorrows Chapel and School, St. Michael
1886-1926	Government Indian School, Fort Totten
1929-1971	Little Flower School, St. Michael

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans in the United States are unknown. However, copies in U.S. repositories cite "Chronicles" of the Soeurs grises, Fort Totten Reservation Schools, 1874-1960, and correspondence by Sister Clapin, S.G.N., 1870s, 1 cubic foot; French and English.
