## History:

1927-present	Congregation of Priests of the Sacred Heart (Hales Corners, Wisconsin) established and have administered St. Joseph's Indian School (Brulé, Sans Arc, Sisseton, and Wahpeton)
1929-1933	Sisters of St. Francis of Philadelphia (Philadelphia, Pennsylvania) staffed the school
1931	A fire destroyed the school, but it reopened later that same year
1933-1971	Benedictine Sisters (Yankton, South Dakota) staffed the school
1971-1972	Dominican Sisters (Oxford, Michigan) staffed the school, in part
1972-1974	Oblate Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament (Marty, South Dakota) staffed the school, in part
1974-1976	Sisters of Mercy (Regional Community of Vermont) staffed the school, in part

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans:

Inclusive dates: 1927-present, n.d.

Volume: 15.5 cubic feet

Description: The records at St. Joseph's School are not arranged according to a classification scheme. Consequently, description is by record type.

- A. House chronicle, 1977-present, 1 volume: handwritten daily entries with information on daily activities, special events, visitors, and the like
- B. "History of St. Joseph's School, 1927-1964, n.d., 199 pages: typed copy; authors not identified
- C. House council meeting minutes, 1948-present, 147 pages
- D. School records, 1927-present, 15.2 cubic feet:
- 1. "Cumulative Records" of students, 1950s-present, 10 cubic feet: divided into inactive files (8 cubic feet) and active files (2 cubic feet); typical files contain an application for enrollment, including supporting

- documentation, such as transcripts, medical reports, photographs, baptismal records, progress reports, and standardized test scores
- "Permanent School Record Cards," 1950s-present, 1 cubic foot: divided into active and inactive records and thereunder arranged alphabetically by surname; information on cards includes annual attendance record, annual scholastic record, and standardized test scores
  - 3. Cards on students, 1930s-1979, 1 cubic foot: arranged chronologically and alphabetically; include name and age of student and family members, data on religious background and past education, and dates when student enrolled and left the School
- 4. "School Records for St. Joseph's Indian School, 1927-1948," 153 pages: records provide the following data: name of student, age, grade, names of parents, address, medical history, religious history, whether student left school or was dismissed, and occasionally photos, clippings, and written comments
- 5. Notebook listing graduates, 1928-present, 1 volume: arranged chronologically and alphabetically
- 6. "General School Administration," 1960s-present, 3 cubic feet: alphabetical subject files
