History: Established in 1911, All Saints (Sans Arc) was administered by diocesan priests until 1953 and by the Congregation of Priests of the Sacred Heart (United States Province, Hales Corners, Wisconsin) from 1953 to the present. All Saints is one of six past and/or present Indian parishes on the Cheyenne River Reservation. The others are Corpus Christi Church, Cheyenne Agency; St. Joseph Church, Cherry Creek; St. Mary Church, La Plant; St. Therese Church, White Horse; and Sacred Heart Church, Dupree. All Saints Church holds the sacramental records for three of these parishes, which are Corpus Christi, St. Mary, and Sacred Heart. The following Sans Arc parishes, missions, and stations on the Cheyenne River Reservation are included within the sacramental books at All Saints Church:
