Inclusive dates: Between 1777-1839

Volume: Few letters

Description: Includes select records (copies) of the Diócesis de Nuevo León (now Arquidiócesis de Monterrey), Mexico, a few of which may pertain to Franciscan missions in Texas; in Spanish.
