Inclusive dates: Between late 17<sup>th</sup> century-1999

Volume: Less than 1 cubic foot

Description: 4 collections are believed to include Native Catholic records.

/1 "Archivo General de Indias, MS I. 1"

Inclusive dates: late 17th-19th centuries

Volume: Few items

Description: Selected records (copies) from Archivo General de Indias, Seville, Spain; in Spanish.

/2 "Archivo General de Mexico, MS I. 2"

Inclusive dates: late 18th-early 19th centuries

Volume: Few items

Description: Selected records (copies) from Archivo General de Indias, Mexico City, Mexico; in Spanish.

/3 "Texas Historical Commission, Architecture Division Records"

Inclusive dates: 1981-1999

Volume: Few items

Description: Needs assessment files with correspondence, clippings, photographs, and notes of endangered historic Indian missions in Texas; re: Our Lady of Mount Carmel (El Paso/ Ysleta), replica of San Francisco de los Tejas, San Lorenzo de la Santa Cruz, and Nuestra Señora de Los Dolores de Los Ais Missions, and a site of visita of Espiritu Santo Mission; finding aid online, <http://www.lib.utexas.edu/taro/index.html>.

/4 "State Parks Board Records"

Inclusive dates: Mostly between 1933-1949

Volume: Few items
