Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans:

Inclusive dates: 1864-1993

Volume: Approximately 1 cubic foot

Description: 6 collections include Native Catholic records.

/1 "Ayres & Ayres, Architects Collection"

Inclusive dates: Between 1894-1977

Volume: Several drawings and photographs

Description: Papers of architects Atlee Bernard Ayres and Robert Moss Ayres; include projects at the Spanish Franciscan missions of Nuestra Señora de la Purísima Concepción de Acuña and San José y San Miguel de Aguayo, both San Antonio, Texas, and Nuestra Señora del Espíritu Santo de Zuniga (La Bahía), Goliad, Texas; finding aid online.

/2 "O'Neil Ford Collection"

Inclusive dates: Between 1864-1993

Volume: Several items

Description: Includes the records of the Texas Old Missions and Forts Restoration Association and the Old Spanish Missions Committee of San Antonio, Texas, which are comprised of clippings, drawings, and photographs; also a drawing of an unidentified Spanish mission in New Mexico; finding aid online.

/3 "Walter Eugene George, Jr. Collection"

Inclusive dates: Between 1951-1979

Volume: Several drawings

Description: Drawings of an architect and historic preservationist; includes San Antonio de Valero [The Alamo] and San José y San Miguel de Aguayo Missions, both San Antonio, Texas; finding aid online.

/4 "Stewart King Collection"

Inclusive dates: Between 1950-1969

Volume: Several items

Description: Drawings, photographs, and notes of landscape architect Stewart King; includes San José y San Miguel de Aguayo, Nuestra Señora de la Purísima Concepción de Acuña, San Francisco de la Espada, and San Juan Capistrano (with aqueduct system) Missions, all San Antonio, Texas; finding aid online.

/5 "Harvey P. Smith Collection"

Inclusive dates: Between 1929-1957

Volume: Several items

Description: Drawings and field notes by architect and historic preservationist Harvey P. Smith, re: San José y San Miguel de Aguayo, Nuestra Señora de la Purísima Concepción de Acuña, San Francisco de la Espada, and San Juan Capistrano Missions, all San Antonio, Texas; finding aid online.

/6 "Robert Leon White Collection"

Inclusive dates: Between 1920-1928

Volume: Several drawings
