History: Founded in 1623, the British/ English Jesuit Province established and administered the Maryland Mission, 1633-ca. 1773, when the English Jesuits were suppressed. The mission evangelized the Piscataway and other American Indians, which began in the Chesapeake Bay and the Potomac River areas and expanded into New York and Pennsylvania.
