History: St. Henry Church is a non-Indian parish. However, Jesuits from St. Henry's attended to students at the Intermountain Inter-Tribal/ Government Indian School, Brigham City, 1950-1984.

History of Intermountain Inter-Tribal/ Government Indian School

1950-1952	Jesuits (California Province, Los Gatos, California) and Maryknoll Sisters (Maryknoll, New York) attended the Intermountain Inter-Tribal/ Government Indian School (Navajo and others) from St. Henry's
1950-1966	Diocesan Council of Catholic Women hosted an annual Christmas party for Catholic students at Intermountain School
1952-1984 (closed)	Jesuits (California Province, Los Gatos, California) attended Intermountain School from St. Henry's
1978-1984 (closed)	Jesuits (California Province, Los Gatos, California) established and staffed the Catholic Center (Navajo and others) at Intermountain School from St. Henry's

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans:

Inclusive dates: 1950-1957, 1973-1984

Volume: Few entries believed among several volumes

Description: Sacramental records for students at the Intermountain School.
