1937-1942	Paulist Fathers (New York, New York) established and administered St. Helen Church (Ute)
1943-1950	Benedictines (St. John's Abbey, Collegeville, Minnesota) administered St. Helen's
1950-1972, 1974-1982, 1984-present	Diocesan priests have administered St. Helen's
1972-1973	Jesuits (California Province, Los Gatos, California) administered St. Helen's
1982-1984	Servites (U.S.A. Province, Chicago, Illinois) administered St. Helen's

1937-1950	Duchesne station
1937-1950	Whiterocks station
1950-present	Holy Spirit Mission, Duchesne
