History: St. Anthony Church is a non-Indian parish. However, diocesan priests from St. Anthony's have attended the following Kalispel Indian mission and parish:

1920s-present	St. Jude Mission, Usk
1940s-present	Our Lady of Sorrows Church, Cusick

History of St. Jude Church

1920s-present	Diocesan priests established and have attended St. Jude Mission (Kalispel), Usk, from St. Anthony's, Newport
ca. 1990-present	Lay volunteers have assisted in administering St. Jude's

History of Our Lady of Sorrows Church

1913-1940s	Jesuits (formerly California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) established and attended Our Lady of Sorrows Mission (Kalispel), Cusick, from St. Francis, Colville
1940s-present	Became a parish; diocesan priests have attended Our Lady of Sorrows from St. Anthony's, Newport

Jesuits from Our Lady of Sorrows attended the Kalispel Government Indian School (Kalispel), Usk, 1920s.
