| 1904-1914 | Diocesan priests established and attended St. Peter Mission from St. Mary Church, Marysville; Chief Seattle (Suquamish) is buried in St. Peter's cemetery |
| 1914-1967 | Jesuits (formerly California; then Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) attended St. Peter's from Seattle College, Seattle |
| 1968-present | Diocesan priests have attended St. Peter's from St Olaf's |
