History: St. Raymond of Peñaford Church is a non-Indian parish that is believed to have a few Winnebago Indian parishioners. St. Raymond's was established in 1998 through the consolidation of three area parishes, one of which was St. Anthony de Padua Church, Augusta. St. Anthony's was a non-Indian parish that had a few Winnebago Indian parishioners. Reverend Georges P. Mathieu (Potawatomi) directed a diocesan Native American ministry, 1972-1980s, which targeted these Indian parishioners.
