1980-1988 (closed) Siggenauk Center (Menominee, Ojibwa, and other), Milwaukee, was established and administered under the auspices of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee with sacraments celebrated and recorded at Christ King, Holy Spirit, St. Barbara, St. Mathew, and St. Michael Churches
