ca. 1930-1969	Grand Ronde Vocational School (Grand Ronde), Grande Ronde, Grand Ronde Reservation, Oregon
ca. 1945-1970	St. Augustine Mission/ Oceanlake station (Siletz), Oceanlake, Oregon
1977-1980	Lovelock Colony station (Paiute and Washo), Lovelock, Nevada
1977-1981	St. Michael Church (Pima), Gila Bend, Arizona
