History: St. Peter Church is a non-Indian parish. However, diocesan priests from St. Peter's attended the following Ojibwa Indian missions and stations:

1909-1914 (transferred to St. Joseph's, Rice Lake)	Couderay station
1909-1914 (transferred to St. Joseph's, Rice Lake)	St. Joseph Mission, Bellilfalls
1915-1917 (transferred to St. Anthony's, Birchwood)	Couderay station
1915-1917 (transferred to St. Anthony's, Birchwood)	St. Joseph Mission, Bellilfalls
1921-1942 (closed)	St. Joseph Mission, Bellilfalls
1943-present	St. Mary Magdalene Mission, Couderay
