UPDATED MCNAIR SCHOLARS PROGRAM NEWS

The Ronald E. McNair Post-Baccalaureate Achievement Program prepares eligible students for graduate school. During the academic year, students attend monthly seminars, meet visiting scholars, and participate in student and professional conferences. During the summer, McNair students participate in the Summer Research Institute, a paid research internship that provides an in-depth research experience. The summer also includes opportunities for working one-on-one with a faculty mentor, learning how to apply to graduate school, and the opportunity to network with other undergraduates from across the nation. To date, fifty (50) MU-McNair Scholars have earned their PhDs. Forty-four (44) MU McNair Scholars have earned other doctoral-level or professional degrees. Two hundred thirty-three (233) MU McNair Scholars have graduated with master's degrees.
