#### **Young Scholar Program**

- College lecture and laboratory experience
- Experience in clinical chemistry, hematology and diagnostic microbiology
- Case-study and problem-based learning

#### Requirements for eligibility:

- High school junior or senior
- In the top 25 percent of your high school class
- Have taken or concurrently taking biology and chemistry

### Successful completion of the program:

- A Marquette University credit will give you a head start to your college career.
- Clinical laboratory knowledge can help with your college major decision.
