The Committee includes five members of the participating faculty along with the provost's designee and an individual from the Office of University Relations. One participating faculty member is elected each year to co-chair the Committee together with the provost's designee. The Committee works collaboratively on behalf of participating faculty across the university and is accountable to the provost.

Full or part-time participating faculty members who have been employed for two-and-a-half or more continuous years are invited to apply for one of the five participating faculty member positions. Applicants should have a demonstrated interest in the work of the Committee and willingness and ability to serve a two-year term.
