Scholarship and optional supplemental materials

There is not a separate application for financial aid because the scholarship committee uses the information from your required materials to make its decision. However, you may choose to send additional information to improve your prospects for admission and financial aid. Examples include:

- Verified information about your academic rank or position in your class, school or country
- Evidence of your social involvement, leadership experience and service to others
- A personal essay with information about your background and plans for the future
