

OBJECTIVE:

Contribute to the Internationalization of the Curricula of Higher Education Institutions applying SUNY's Collaborative Online International Learning (COIL) methodology for strengthening academic programs in Mexican and U.S. universities.

COIL METHODOLOGY:

- It is a teaching-learning methodology that provides internationalization strategies using online technologies, bringing intercultural experiences and global earning to the classroom.
- It encourages the creation of learning environments where instructors work together to generate a shared study program that emphasizes collaborative and experiential learning.

- Enthusiasm for innovative, collaborative, and interdisciplinary teaching.
- Experience in instructional design and information technologies skills applied to teaching.
- Commitment to participate in training workshops on COIL methodology, and to work with a Mexican professor to offer jointly a COIL course.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE:

- 1. Search for partners registering at www.ampei.org.mx
- 2. COIL training offered by Mexican COIL experts to U.S. and Mexican faculty that will design and teach jointly a COIL course. It includes two workshops:
 - **a. Fundamentals on COIL** methodology, offered in we binars with real-time interaction. Duration: 8 hrs.
 - b. COIL component design, workshop offered online with mentoring sessions every week.
 Duration: 3 weeks.
- 3. Implementation of the COIL course, with coaching and support by mentors experts in COIL.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

- Interested U.S. faculty must register in the program providing contact data, institution, courses usually taught, research interests, and description of the proposed COIL course.
- If U.S. faculty do not have a Mexican partner, they will be supported by the PIC US-MX team to contact potential peers.
- Accepted participants must complete COIL training organized by AMPEI. Please check the calendar of workshops offered every semester, available in www.ampei.org.mx

PROGRAM DURATION:

- U.S. faculty must apply in the semester before the session when they plan to teach the COIL course.
- Call for participation is open for U.S. faculty to join in sessions Fall 2020, Spring 2021, Fall 2021 and Spring 2022.
