Marquette Online Course Evaluation System (MOCES) Instructor Evaluation Results

The results of the course evaluations are not released until after all final grades for all classes have been submitted to the registrar. At that point, instructors will have access to the aggregated results of their evaluation and the student comments.

The instructor cannot see individual responses nor can the instructor determine who submitted the comments. The instructor also does not know which students responded; the instructor only knows the number of responses and the total enrollment of the class. Below is a sample evaluation report that instructors receive.

In addition to the report below, instructors also see department, college, and university averages for all the items on the survey for comparison.
