CAMPUS COMMUNITY FUNDING REQUEST INFORMATION

The Campus Community Fee is the offspring of an aggressive, proactive plan to strengthen Marquette's campus community, enrich the intellectual climate and intensify cultivation of the values and principles central to a Catholic, Jesuit education. Money raised by the fee will support many student organizations including Club Sports. The fee allocation is under the direction of the Club Sports Director and Recreational Sports Director who review and approve all funding requests. Funding requests may include: uniform and equipment purchases, travel expense, and other expenses per approval of the Club Sports Director.

The following parameters guide the Director in making these decisions:

1. Club Sports eligible must be registered at the time of application with the Office of Student Life and be in good standing.
2. Club Sports eligible must be in good standing with the Recreational Sports Department. All Club Sport forms must be on file in the Recreational Sports office. The Club President or club representative must attend every Club Sports Advisory Council meeting, excused absences are at the discretion of the Club Sports Director.
3. Funding requests will be accepted for travel expenses and equipment expenses. Funding will not be approved for any delinquent or past bills of any type.
4. The Club President must meet with the Club Sports Director to discuss the funding request.
5. Invoices or receipts must be turned in for all approved funding requests.
6. Funds allocated for a specific request must be utilized for that request.
7. There are no limits on the number of times a club may apply for funding.
