PROGRAM COMPONENTS

The course on “Comparative Crime and Punishment” provides Marquette University students with the opportunity to study comparative crime and punishment issues with students from the University of Tampere in Finland. The study program includes guest lectures of leading specialists, researchers and prison workers and field trips to functioning prisons in Finland, Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania. Students’ academic focus on comparative crime, punishment, and the ideal of social justice embedded in the Finnish crime control policy, will be complemented by first-hand experience of Finland, Estonia, Lithuania and Latvia through historical and cultural site visits, including local guided tours, and traditional cuisine.
