Mashuda Hall is located near the historic Pabst Mansion on the western edge of Marquette University's campus. Prior to its purchase by Marquette in 1980, Mashuda was known as the Coach House Motor Inn, where the Beatles stayed during their first Wisconsin appearance at the Milwaukee Arena in 1964.

Mashuda is air-conditioned and its spacious rooms are furnished with extra-long, twin beds, dressers, desks and chairs. Bed and bath linens and complimentary Wi-Fi are provided. Guests will want to bring their personal toiletries. Other building amenities include secured 24-hour front desk service, a coin-operated laundry, vending machines, irons/ironing board and gathering areas to relax, watch television or play a game of pool or ping pong.

For an additional fee, guests also have access to overnight parking in a nearby campus lot, meal service in a residence hall dining room and the Helfaer Recreation Center. Located less than three blocks from Mashuda, the Rec Center features six indoor tennis courts, a swimming pool, fully equipped fitness/weight room, two saunas and a multipurpose room with space for five basketball courts, four volleyball courts, three badminton courts and a jogging lane.
