## PROGRAMS

- **Semester programs** are available for College of Arts & Sciences students in over 50 locations all around the world.
- **Short-term programs** are available during J session, spring break, and summer terms and offer a variety of alternatives to semester-long programs.
- **Faculty-led programs** are short-term study abroad programs in which students travel abroad with a faculty member. ARSC offers several of these programs each year during J session, spring break, and summer.

## LANGUAGE MAJORS OR MINORS

There is no better way to learn a language than to immerse yourself in it through an academic experience abroad! Marquette offers languages from Spanish, Italian, French, German, Chinese, and Arabic. Students can study at international programs in regions where these languages are spoken primarily. It's possible to fit this language experience into your four-year plan!

## RECOMMENDED TERM

The best term to study abroad will depend on your major, academic goals, and preferences. Most students study abroad during their sophomore or junior year of study.

## INTERNSHIPS

Are very possible to do while studying abroad, and can be a defining aspect of an education abroad experience!

## LOGISTICS

- Talk to your academic adviser about when the best time to go abroad would be in your college career to plan your course options. You can go abroad as soon as summer after freshman year. All majors can study abroad!
- General cost: MU tuition + insurance + passport/visa+ airfare + housing/food. Costs vary by program and location.
