

# STUDY ABROAD BUSINESS GUIDE



## PROGRAMS

- **Semester programs** are available for College of Business Administration students in over 50 locations all around the world.
- **Short-term programs** are available during J session, spring break, and summer terms and offer a variety of alternatives to semester-long programs.
- **Faculty-led programs** are short-term study abroad programs in which students travel abroad with a faculty member. COBA offers several of these programs each year during J session, spring break, and summer.

## RECOMMENDED TERM

The best time to study abroad will depend on your area of study, academic goals, and preferences. Business students go abroad as soon as the summer after freshman year of study and through second semester of their senior years of study. Traveling earlier in your course of study can provide more flexibility in choosing courses and the option to complete an internship to be more competitive in the job market after graduation.
