OTHER STUDY ABROAD OPPORTUNITIES

- **Semester programs** are available for Education students in over 50 locations all around the world.
- **Short-term programs** are available during J session, spring break, and summer terms and offer a variety of alternatives to semester long programs.
- **Faculty-led programs** are short-term study abroad programs in which students travel abroad with a faculty member. A variety of these programs are offered each year during J session, spring break, and summer.

LOGISTICS

- Talk to your academic adviser about when the best time to go abroad would be to plan your course options. You can study abroad as soon as summer after freshman year. All majors can study abroad!
- General cost: MU tuition + insurance + passport/visa+ airfare + housing/food. Cost vary by program and location.
- Scholarships are available to students planning on studying abroad. Take a look at scholarship opportunities on our website for more information.

It is important to note that while students studying abroad for the semester may be able to engage in teaching experiences or observation, any teaching experience abroad does not satisfy the MU Education required field experience/observation hours due to certification and licensure regulations.
