PROGRAM COMPONENTS

The course takes an experiential approach to the study of Arab and Islamic history and heritage of the Iberian Peninsula. For almost 800 years, between 711 and 1492, the territory of present-day Spain saw a succession of prosperous Islamic states. Currently Spain is one of the main destinations for Arab and Muslim immigrants as well as tourists. Through the readings in history, anthropology and migrations studies, tourist guides, and the press, as well as through student-guided tours and the meetings with community members, students will explore the Islamic cultures intertwined in Spanish identity, learn how to recognize and interpret architectural styles, acquire the foundations of art history, and develop a working knowledge of the current debates involving Islam in Spain.
