Appendix D: Supplier and Workforce Diversity Inclusion Plan and Reporting Requirements

It is the policy of Marquette University to ensure that minority and women owned businesses (MWBE) are given equal access and opportunity to provide high quality goods and services to any and all aspects of our organization. Marquette University is committed to being a leader in the development of mutually beneficial relationships with diverse suppliers and to being a leader within its' industry and community within the area of supplier diversity. The diversity inclusion plan is referenced in the university purchasing policy and is an important amendment to ensure consistency in application, reporting and action.

This plan summary provides information to contractors and suppliers regarding the inclusion requirements for Minority and Women Business Enterprises ("MWBE"), the use of minority and women workers ("MWW"), Apprentice, Neighborhood Residents and Interns during the construction, maintenance, and operations of Marquette University Project(s), hereafter referred to as "construction". This plan summary has been prepared as a guide and is designed to assist all contractors and major suppliers in understanding the inclusion and reporting requirements. It also contains important provisions, requirements, and recommendations relative to the utilization of diverse suppliers and workers. Although the language and requirements are targeted at construction and related services, the **theme of the policy extends to all purchases on campus**. The complete <u>Workforce Diversity Inclusion Plan</u> is available on the Supplier Web site and the participation requirements are:

- 1. Include at least one certified and qualified ethnically diverse or women owned supplier be included in all subcontract bid opportunities. Special attention should be given to targeting local suppliers, based on a "bullseye" approach, with preference to suppliers located in proximity to the Marquette campus, city of Milwaukee and Southeastern Wisconsin; and to right-size business opportunities to better match the capabilities of local firms.
- 2 Minority and/or Women Business Enterprises will receive contracts that total a minimum of 15% of the professional services and construction costs.
- 3. Minority and Women workers will perform a minimum of 15% of the total hours worked on the project.
- 4 Apprentice and On-The-Job Trainees will be employed by each contractor and subcontractor in accordance with the maximum ratio of apprentices to journeymen established for this project. (This requirement is not intended to over employ resources and exceptions to the ratio are allowed when only one person is required for the work). See Exhibit 1.
- 5. Each contractor will make a good faith effort to hire at least one individual that lives in the Milwaukee County's zip codes identified as high poverty and/or 80-100% distressed. These zip codes are 53204, 53205, 53206, 53208, 53209, 53210, 53212, 53215, 53216, 53218, 53224, 53223, 53225, 53233.
- 6. Each contractor is encouraged to engage at least one Marquette University student as an intern

Activity and Reporting Requirements

The following forms are to be used in the planning and reporting upon award. NOTE: Reporting documents should be submitted to Facilities Planning & Management at <u>fpm-VendorRelations@marquette.edu</u> by the 1st of the month following the previous quarter; Report due April 30 for Jan-March; July 30 for April-June; October 31 for July-September; January 31 for October-December; and at project completion.

- All contractors are required to maintain and provide documentation of diversity supplier certification for one year after completion of the project.
- All contractors are required to maintain and provide documentation of labor participation and necessary documentation of employee addresses, etc. for one year after completion of the project
